



Q2 - On average, how often do you visit the physical library?





Q3 - What time of day do you spend the most time in the library?





Q4 - On average, how often during this semester did you stay until midnight?





Q5 - During this semester, did you come to the library on weekends? (Select all that apply.)





Q6 - Did you ever need to stay past the library's closing time on the weekends?








Q11 - Currently the University Library is open until midnight Monday through Thursday. If the library were to extend their open hours, how likely would you stay past midnight?






